MARINERS ARE WARNED that surveys carried out on the 2nd August 2021 and 28th September 2021 show the following: -

- 1) Depths of between 0 metres at Chart Datum and 1.4 metres **ABOVE** Chart Datum exist in the navigable channel from 920 metres downstream to 10 metres upstream of the No. 23 Light Buoy.
- 2) Depths of between 0 metres at Chart Datum and 0.7 metres **ABOVE** Chart Datum exist in the navigable channel from 250 metres to 600 metres upstream of the No. 23 Light Buoy.
- 3) A least depth of 0.6 metres **ABOVE** Chart Datum exists South of the Ships course in the vicinity of the No. 23 Light Buoy.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that 1.4 metres **ABOVE** Chart Datum should be used for passage planning purposes and Notices to Mariners H. 114/2021 is hereby cancelled.
