ROYAL NATIONAL LIFEBOAT INSTITUTION 200-YEAR ANNIVERSARY

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that Associated British Ports will be supporting the 200-year anniversary of the Royal National Lifeboat Institute (RNLI) on Monday 04 March 2024.

The charity has a remarkable 200-year story – from oar-powered boats to the modern boats used today; from introducing the first lifeboats on the River Thames to rolling-out a lifeguard service on over 240 UK beaches and from running the UK's biggest drowning prevention campaigns to working with others overseas.

Funded by voluntary donations, and with lifeboats crewed by specially trained volunteers, the RNLI is a truly unique rescue organisation that has saved over 144,000 lives since 1824.

In appreciation for the RNLI, we invite you to sound your horns in unison – one continuous blast (of no longer than one minute) - at 1200 hrs UTC, on Monday 04 March 2024.

ABP is encouraging vessels to participate should they wish to do so.
