RIVER HUMBER - NEW HOLLAND DOCK

SCHEDULED WORKS TO REMOVE THE EASTERN BULLNOSE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday 05 March 2024 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for an approximate period of 26 weeks, scheduled works will be undertaken to remove the Eastern bullnose and reconstruct the quay wall at New Holland Dock.

The bullnose will be marked by two piles on the North and South corners of the Eastern bullnose to indicate the extremities with 2 vertical fixed yellow lights and a yellow flag.

All works will be done from shore and shall not extend more than 0.5m beyond the western limit of the Eastern bullnose and will retain a clear vertical face with no underwater obstructions to continue to provide safe access for vessels.

No workboats are expected to be engaged in the works.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to contact VTS Humber on VHF Channel 12 upon arrival and departure from the Dock and New Holland Dock on VHF Channel 22 to ascertain any extra local restrictions in force.

MARINERS ARE FURTHER REQUESTED to pass at slow speed to avoid creating a wash when works are being carried out.
