RIVER HUMBER

HAWKE CHANNEL - SHOAL WATER

MARINERS ARE WARNED that a survey carried out on the 15th March 2022 shows that depths of less than 9.7 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 15 metres into the South side of the Hawke channel from 220 metres to 420 metres upstream of the No. P4 Light Buoy.

Masters of Very Large Vessels (VLS) should take these depths into account when preparing passage plans as they may be impeded by the encroachment.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that Notice to Mariners No. H. 153/2021 is hereby cancelled.
