

# **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

## No. H. 57/2024

### RIVER HUMBER

#### SOUTH KILLINGHOLME - OUTFALL DREDGING OPERATIONS

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that commencing Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2024 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of approximately four weeks, intertidal dredging operations will be undertaken, approximately 370m upstream of South Killingholme Oil Jetty.

Part of the dredging works will be carried out over a period of approximately 2 weeks by the cutter suction dredger '**JOHN M**' (Loa 30.5m Beam 6m).

While '**JOHN M**' is on station a 400mm diameter discharge pipe will be anchored below the surface with the offshore extremity encroaching 90m into the navigational channel in position Latitude 53° 39' 06.46" N, Longitude 000° 12' 42.86" W and marked by 2 yellow buoys exhibiting the following characteristics FI.Y.2s.

The 'JOHN M' will liaise closely with VTS Humber during the works advising of any planned movements. They will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 12 and 16.

**MARINERS ARE WARNED** to exercise care and caution in the area and should pass at **SLOW SPEED** to avoid creating a wash.
