KING GEORGE DOCK, HULL – APPROACH JETTY FENDER REFURBISHMENT WORKS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing on Thursday 5th May 2022 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) for a period of twelve weeks, fender refurbishment works will be conducted on the east and west approach jetties at King George Dock, Hull.

The works will be undertaken during daylight hours.

The crane barge '**COLLINGHAM**' (Loa 43.8m Beam 8.56m), workboat '**REBECCA M**' (Loa 36m Beam 10.21m) and safety boat '**JOHN ELLIOTT**' (Loa 12m Beam 5m) will carry out the works and will contact VTS and the Assistant Dockmaster, Hull on VHF on commencement and completion of daily operations.

The '**COLLINGHAM**', '**REBECCA M**' and '**JOHN ELLIOTT**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 11.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to navigate with caution in the vicinity of these works and to pass at a reduced speed to avoid creating a wash.
