# HALTON MIDDLE & STALLINGBOROUGH FLATS SURVEY EQUIPMENT DEPLOYMENT

**MARINERS ARE ADVISED** that on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June (or as soon after as circumstances permit) for a period of 2 days, three survey seabed frames and attached marker buoys will be deployed in positions:

Latitude 53° 40.189' N Longitude 000° 12.424' (WGS 84) Latitude 53° 36.594' N Longitude 000° 06.457' (WGS 84) Latitude 53° 36.372' N Longitude 000° 05.138' (WGS 84)

The marker buoys will be special marks with the light characteristics VQ. Y.

The devices will be deployed by the vessel "**UKD SEAHORSE**" (LOA 25.97m Beam 10.06m) call sign 'which will display the lights and signals prescribed in the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will liaise with VTS Humber and maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 12 and 68.

**MARINERS ARE FURTHER ADVISED** that the survey equipment will remain in place for a period of approximately 35 days.

MARINERS ARE REQUIRED to navigate with caution in these areas.
