HUMBER APPROACHES

ROSSE REACH SURVEY OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing Thursday 13th June (or as soon after as circumstances permit), for a period of approximately two days, survey operations will be taking place around the Outer Rosse Reach including periods within the traffic separation scheme.

The 4.5m unmanned survey vessel **'X-16'** callsign 'MKMB2' will be engaged in the survey works supported by the 13m guard vessel **'New Life'** callsign 'MHXG7'.

The **'X-16'** and **'New Life'** will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 14 and 16.

MARINERS ARE REQUIRED to navigate with caution during these operations.
