

NOTICE TO MARINERS

RIVER HUMBER

HALTON MIDDLE - SHOAL WATER

MARINERS ARE WARNED that surveys carried out on the 12th and 13th May 2022 show the following: -

 Depths of between 4.6 metres and 5.5 metres below Chart Datum have encroached into the West side of the channel from 835 metres downstream of the No. 12 Killingholme Light Buoy to the No. 12 Killingholme Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists to the East in this vicinity.

2) Depths of between 5.1 metres and 5.5 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 40 metres into the West side of the channel from the No. 12 Killingholme Light Buoy to 120 metres upstream of the No. 14 Skitter Haven Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists to the East in this vicinity.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that 5.5 metres below Chart Datum should be used for passage planning purposes and Notice to Mariners No. H. 10/2022 is hereby cancelled.
