### STALLINGBOROUGH TO HULL SURVEY OPERATIONS

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June (or as soon as circumstances permit) for a period of approximately 14 days, there will be numerous small scale bathymetric, water quality and dye dispersion survey operations taking place between the Number 8 Middle Burcom Buoy and Alexandra Dock, Hull.

The survey vessels '**CHRISTINE H**' (LOA 7.9m Beam 2.0m) call sign '**MDMI7**' and '**PRECISION 1**' (LOA 12m Beam 6m) call sign '**2FCD2**' will be engaged in the operations and will contact VTS Humber on commencement and completion of each operation to ensure commercial traffic is not impeded.

The '**CHRISTINE H**' and '**PRECISION 1**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 12 and 16.

**MARINERS ARE REQUESTED** to exercise care and caution when navigating in the area.
