EMERGENCY ARRANGEMENTS

INCIDENT ABOARD SHIP - In the event of an emergency requiring Police, Fire or Ambulance call the 'MARINE CONTROL CENTRE' on 11 or 9, or 'VTS HUMBER' on channel 16 or 12. If no contact is possible by radio then dial '999' on the ship's cell phone or nearest public telephone call box (see plan). No money required. In all cases:

1. Say which emergency service you need.
2. Give the **vessel's name and berth.**
3. Inform Port Security:

Keep a listening watch on any of the above VHF channels until emergency services arrive. If the **Port Emergency Plan** is activated. Channel 11 or 9 will be used for marine communications.

A medical centre is situated at North Gap. King George Dock. tel. (01482) 712113, and is open from 0800 to 1600 Monday to Friday.

INCIDENT ASHORE - If a major emergency occurs within the port which may affect your vessel. You will be informed as soon as possible and advised of what to do.

Be prepared to stop cargo operations, keep people indoors and move your ship and keep a listening watch on VHF channel 11 or 9 until further notice.

NOTE: You are required to immediately report to the Duty Assistant Dock Master (ADM) any serious incident involving dangerous substances, which might have caused serious personal injury or a risk to the safety of your vessel.

You must keep your vessel in a state of readiness to be moved at any time unless the ADM agrees otherwise. Please note if you are berthed at a Terminal not operated by ABP, that the Terminal will have emergency arrangements in addition to those above.

Any suspicious persons, items or activities should be reported immediately to the Marine Control Centre
