ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE DREDGING ON INTAKES AND OUTFALL AT KEADBY POWER STATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Wednesday 7th January 2026 (or as soon after as circumstances permit), for a period of approximately two days, essential maintenance dredging will be carried out on the intakes and outfall at Keadby Power Station.

The dredger '**REBECCA-M**' (LOA 35m Beam 10m) will carry out the works. The vessel will be moored alongside the two locations and will be using a dredge pump to disperse the dredge material into the river.

The '**REBECCA-M**' will be manned throughout and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 17 and 15.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to contact '**REBECCA-M**' prior to approaching the operating area.

MARINERS ARE FURTHER REQUESTED to reduce speed when passing the '**REBECCA-M**' to avoid creating a wash.
